



## Grants

Grants from the Indiana Soybean Alliance (ISA) are intended to financially assist farmers as they plan and carry through on farm outreach programs in their communities. The grants are matching grants to compensate the time and resources donated by the community the farmer lives in.

Examples of programs that may receive grants include but are not limited to:

- Local community event activities
- Neighbor appreciation dinners on farm
- Hosting a community group on farm
- Networking program with non-farm organizations
- Humanitarian programs such as food drives

### *Application Guidelines*

1. Submit completed application and program budget one month in advance of activity.
2. Requests must be for specific projects or events that promote the mission of ISA.
3. *Grant* will not exceed one-half of estimated costs and will be given at the completion of the activity.
4. Applicant must verify the costs before ISA will approve funding. Proposal must include a budget of the project or event.
5. Awarding of grants is not automatic and will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Funding is limited and determinations are based on budget, program content and need.
